SITE RULES

- 1 All site operatives, including visitors, shall wear protective headgear, high visibility clothing, suitable footwear, eye protection, ear protection and dust masks having due regard to the progress of the works.
- 2 Smoking on site is only allowed in designated areas and alcoholic drink and non-prescribed drugs are not permitted on site, as are people adversely influenced thereby.
- 3 Radios or any noise generating entertainment systems are not permitted on site.
- 4 Explosives are not permitted to be used on site.
- 5 Bonfires are not permitted on site.
- 6 Mechanical plant which requires specific training in the use thereof must only be operated by duly qualified operatives.
- 7 Loading and unloading of deliveries will be carried out in such a way to avoid inconvenience to neighbours and members of the public
- 8 Site operatives vehicles will be parked on site if possible, vehicles parked on public roads to be parked in such a way as to not cause nuisance to neighbours and other road users
- 9 Considerate Contractor's Scheme.
If the site is registered with the scheme and all operatives should ensure that they are aware of the principles and requirements for the scheme
- 10 Dust pollution. Due to the presence of neighbouring properties and to ensure the health of site workers and prevent nuisance to the general public dust pollution is to be controlled. Operatives should ensure that they are aware of and follow the site procedures, details of which are included in the site induction. Dust is being monitored on this site.
- 11 Site Waste Management Plan. Copy available in site office, all timber and plasterboard to be segregated and not placed in mixed waste skip. Any surplus (unused) material (not waste) to be removed from site by the sub-contractor that brought it to site. All sub-contractors removing or arranging for the removal of waste from site are to ensure that the Site Manager is provided with the necessary information to complete the Waste Data Collection Form.
- 12 Noise Prevention, no specific requirement as the site is located on an industrial estate.
- 13 Any phone calls made or received on site must be done from solid ground or site offices, no phone calls can be made or received on the scaffold.



DELIVERIES TO / COLLECTIONS FROM

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PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING

- The site is accessed from Lyndhurst Crescent. All Deliveries must be driven into and out of site, not reversed. Reversing on site will be with the aid of a banksman.
- The site is located on a housing estate with residential properties, a village hall and a primary school near to the site.
- There are public footpaths that cross the site entrance and extra care must be taken when crossing these to gain access/egress to/from the site. Any pedestrians using the footpath **MUST BE** given priority.
- To reduce congestion on the local highways, reduce transport times and avoid school opening & closing times please avoid making deliveries/collections between 08:00 and 09.15, or between 14.45 and 15.30.
- Please advise site manager (telephone number will be on order) of anticipated arrival time to help with management of vehicles on site which will keep any waiting time to a minimum.
- Once on site obey the instructions of the Banksman who will direct you to the designated area for loading/unloading.
